Now, to address your question of "Can you clarify what you need from MDE?" It is my plea that MDE would uphold their responsibility to ensure that the owner of Day Village hire an independent and accredited by MDE a Risk Assessor or an Inspector Technician to take dust wipe and soil samples before any tenant occupies the unit as mandated by MDE since this facility with 400 units is still undergoing renovations and remodeling and is an affected property. As noted in the Exhibits that accompanied my 5-18-26 email, my soul mate for over 40 wonderful years, Mr. Jimmy Porter, myself, and our son have been promised that we could move into unit "136" as part of a "Relocation" not a transfer, but we have not been privileged to any documentation from MDE of clearance testing since I requested the documentation around 5-6-26. Thus, as a FOI request, I'm requesting that I receive a copy of the clearance testing for unit "136" of Day Village and a copy of all the clearance testing result of all the units because tenants are moving in and I've witnessed gross and improper protocols being utilized in performing "Abatement" work as cited on a post that was on the doors and/or lead hazard reductions, which include improper worksite preparation, worker protection, and the most horrific containment of the microscopic lead dust particles that are released when performing abatement and/or other lead hazard control.
