undergoing major renovations through abatement and lead risk reductions and containment protocols were not being utilized to prevent environmental of exposure of minute lead-dust particles in the soil; and, if new tenants are occupying the unit/s that have not received clearance testing for lead through dust and soil sampling, then remove the tenants to lead safe housing and remove the new carpeting and padding before taking the dust wipe samples from the floors; if the owners intend to reuse the new carpeting and padding, then have the carpet and padding, also, tested for lead dust clearance. Furthermore, since I observed very little containment taking place during the window replacements and the removal of other lead-based components such as the doors and other interior components, it is my prayer that dust sampling be taken from the vents, also. 2.) As a result of my FOIA request in my "reply" email dated 5-19-26, ensure that MDE issues me a copy of the clearance testing from the dust and soil sampling of all the units at Day Village that have been abated and/or that have undergone lead risk reductions and that EPA and HUD, also, receive copies of these documents.

As declared in my 5-18-26 email to the manager of Day Village, the assistant manager of Day Village, the owner of Day Village Drucker and Faulk, Dr. Suzanne, and Ms. Serena .... "I'm blessed by the TRINE GOD to be a Lead Abatement and Demolition Contractor, an Inspector Technician, and a Clearance Examiner who can perform dust wipe sampling and soil sampling as mandated and in accordance with MDE's protocol for dust wipe sampling and soil sampling. ....
